CERTIFICATE IN REPRODUCTIVE & SEXUAL HEALTH COURSE (NURSING) FORMAT:

- PART ONE:** Well Women's Health Unit HLTASXH002
PART TWO: Reproductive & Sexual Health for Nurses Theory Component
PART THREE: Clinical Training Component

Recommended order of completion but option to complete part two as stand alone course.

THEORY TRAINING June 17 – 21 2025

PRE REQUISITES

- Open to Registered Nurses, Midwives, Allied Health Professionals, Enrolled Nurses and Registered Aboriginal Health Practitioners.
- Minimum of one year post graduate experience.
- Current APHRA Registration.

RECOMMENDED (but not essential)

- Completion of HLTASXH002 (Well Women's Health Unit) or equivalent.

COURSE OVERVIEW AND STRUCTURE

- Five days face to face lectures, panel discussions and adult learning activities facilitated by subject matter experts across all areas of reproductive and sexual health.
- Participants will develop their theoretical knowledge of evidence based best practice through case studies, role play and small group work.

ASSESSMENT

- Compulsory 5 day face to face attendance.
- Workbook submission within 6 weeks of face to face course attendance.
- FPWNT Certificate in Reproductive & Sexual Health (Theory) will be issued on successful completion of the above.

CLINICAL TRAINING 2025

PLACES SUBJECT TO TRAINING CAPACITY

PRE REQUISITES

- Successful completion of the Certificate in Reproductive & Sexual Health for Nurses (Theory).
- Clinical training places are subject to availability.

COURSE OVERVIEW AND ASSESSMENT

- 40 – 50 hours of supervised clinical training where participants are supported in the application of their theoretical knowledge within a clinical setting to expand their R&SH practice.
- To be completed within 12 months of attaining the Certificate in Reproductive & Sexual Health for Nurses (Theory).

ASSESSMENT

- Certificate in Reproductive & Sexual Health for Nurses (Clinical) will be issued on successful completion of the clinical requirements outlined above.
- This certification is recognised within Family Planning Organisations across Australia.

FEES: \$1,283 incl. GST

- Fees fall due upon notification of acceptance into the training.
- Fees must be paid in full prior to commencement of the training.
- Payment plans are available.
